Dear Skater,

Enclosed is the MFSC Winter Ice Contract for sessions from January 2, 2012 through April 28, 2012. Our comprehensive program reflects the ongoing effort to offer the best skating opportunities for all levels of skaters. Our goal is to provide a program which continues to allow the club to grow and remain financially strong while creating an environment which promotes and encourages our skaters to excel. Please refer to the contract packet for additional contract details or our website – [www.mentorfsc.com](http://www.mentorfsc.com). Please read the contract carefully.

Due to the popularity of this policy, we are again offering discounts for those who pay in full and/or mail their contract on time. The contract should be mailed to Deanna DiCola (address below) with a postmark on or before **December 19, 2011**. If a contract session you have requested has been filled, we will work with you to identify alternatives. **To be considered on-time the contract must be completely filled out, signed, and the required payment received or postmarked by December 19, 2011. Late contracts will not be guaranteed requested placement, and discounts will not be allowed.**

**Please note your contract will be processed only if you are a USFS member with a current MFSC home or associate membership and in good standing.** Each contracted skater must be a home MFSC club member or an associate MFSC club member with their membership renewed for 2011/2012 season. Membership applications can be found on our website.

**Highlights of the winter 2012 contract include:**

- Weekday morning ice will be offered Tuesday through Friday from 6:00-7:30 am
- Saturday Club Ice will be a 90 minute session but you only pay for 60 minutes. Only 60 minutes credits/exchanges or punches will be given/taken for this session.
- An incredibly low priced OFF ice class will again be offered Thursdays from 6:35-7:05 pm in between our club sessions so that all skaters may take advantage. The class will be Core\*Strength\*Stretch.
- Please note the schedule changes for the following sessions in March and April: Mondays starting March 19 (15 minutes later), Tuesdays starting March 20 (1 and ¾ hours later) and Thursdays starting March 22 (15 minutes later).
- There are some session cancellations for sessions throughout the contract period due to schedule conflicts with other groups and spring break. Please refer to the Schedule for specific information.
- We will again offer several **basic skills/open free** sessions, for those skaters that have passed Basic 1 or Tot 1 or higher (versus all other sessions requiring that Basic 6 skills have been mastered). On the basic/open session doubles are allowed, but you must yield to newer skaters.
- An **Open freestyle/dance** session is offered on Mondays.
- Learn To Skate lessons are offered in conjunction with our club ice on Wednesdays 6:45-7:30 (junior Club, Basic 7/8) and Saturdays 11:00-11:45 (Basic 5 /6). Refer to our LTS discussion page.
- City ice freestyle will be offered on Fridays from 4:00-5:00 pm. Additional city ice details can be found within contract.
- Use the enclosed Contract schedule and pricing form to circle the sessions you are requesting and attach the Contract Summary Form. *The first payment, plus registration fee is due by December 19, 2011 to reserve your seniority basis.* All payments are to be sent directly to:

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## Terms and Conditions

- **MEMBERSHIP** - Contracts will only be processed for current MFSC Home and Associate members in **good standing**. **To remain in good standing with MFSC, all accounts, including club ice and MFSC affiliated contracts & payments, must be paid current according to the terms stated.**
  - **CONTRACTS** -
    - Contracts are binding for the **entire** contract period of January 2, 2012 through April 28, 2012. If a contract is submitted after the start of the contract period beginning January 2, 2012, the contract **will not be prorated** for the week you submit the contract unless you are a newly contracting skater or if it is after 2/6/12. Ice Credits will be issued for any sessions missed due to turning in the contract after the session start date of January 2, 2012 or for any contract changes.
    - Release from a contract requires a MFSC Board decision
      - Injury / Illness confirmed with signed documentation by a physician
      - Written request directly to the MFSC Board
      - Two weeks are reduced from all affirmative requests
    - Late contracts will not be guaranteed requested placement
    - Sessions will be contracted based on: 1) MFSC contract seniority if contract received **on or before** the deadline; 2) MFSC Home Club membership; 3) Availability
  - **PAYMENTS** (Please be advised that the following payment schedule and late payment process will be strictly adhered to) -
    - Make check or money order payable to **Mentor Figure Skating Club (MFSC)**
    - Payment of the 1<sup>st</sup> third of this contract **AND** your registration is due postmarked on December 19, 2011.
    - **The second payment is due February 6 and final payment March 6, 2012.** Unless it is the final payment, all payments will be at least 1/3 of contract or \$100, whichever is **higher**
    - **Late Payment Process**
      - ***Due Date – payment is received by the ice administrator at the address listed below***
      - ***Fee of \$20 will be assessed for all late payments beyond 5 days of the due date***
      - ***Fee of \$25 will be assessed for all NSF checks***
      - ***Skaters that are more than 10 days late with any payment will not be permitted to skate during MFSC sessions or participate in club sponsored functions such as test sessions or competitions***
    - If you cannot meet the payment schedule, please contact the Ice Administrator **BEFORE** the payment due date and make arrangements for payments

- **SESSION CAPACITIES** – 24 skaters per session maximum for Open Free sessions; 20 skaters per session maximum for High Free sessions; 12 maximum per off-ice session.
  - **FREESTYLE SESSIONS** –Open Free sessions are open to Basic 6 and above. Basic Skills sessions are open to Basic 1 or Tot 1 and above. The Open Free/Dance session will allow skaters to practice their moves, freestyle, jumps, spins, synchro (up to 2 skaters), solo dance, and partner dance without the restriction of number of skaters on the ice. Our normal open sessions allow skaters to work on the same skills but you cannot do synchro (up to 2 skaters) or partner dance (2 skaters) if there are more than 16 skaters on the ice.

Clinic Description: Want an opportunity to learn exercises to improve your flexibility, balance, and core and extremity strength? Got time between Thursday evening sessions? Participants must be 6 or older and able to pay attention during a 30 minute class. 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## MFSC Exchange Policy

The MFSC has continued to offer the flexibility of requesting off ice and on ice credits when needed. Each Contracted Skater will be allowed an equivalent number of exchange credits up to the entire value of their contract. Exchanges can be made within the week (beginning Sunday) that you are contracted but not pulled forward from a future week. Recording of exchanges must be made by a Monitor or with a Monitor's or Ice Administrator's approval. Exchange credits must be recorded both on the skater's personal exchange form **and** in the daily contracted sheets to properly record attendance status.

You must either leave a message on the answering machine or have a Monitor or Ice Administrator fill out the skater's personal exchange form up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the requested exchange session(s). Credits requested less than 30 minutes before the ice session will not be granted. No exchanges will be made after the session has started. All exchange credits will expire at the end of the contract period that the exchanges were made. The Club's answering machine phone number is (440) 205-8498. Do NOT call the front desk at the Ice Arena; they will not take a message.

**Guidelines for Utilizing Exchanges** - If you have questions, please contact the Ice Administrator prior to assuming the solution and make note on the daily sheet detailing what has been done and/or requested.

- Total Exchanges Used must be no greater than Requested Credits earned. (Running Total of Used Exchanges must be < or = the running total of Requested credits made available.)
- Ice session exchanges earn 1 credit for each 15 minutes of the scheduled session.
- Credits must be taken or used for the entire scheduled session.
- When calling **440-205-8498**, identify the skater, date and the session they will be missing.
- The monitor will record the request on the skater's personal exchange form where a running total is kept and also mark on the daily contracted attendance sheet.
- All exchange credits must be used within the current contract period (no carry-overs).
